POSELLA TODAY

Polesella represents a little village on Po's left shore with a difficult relationship with the River in the past but with a possible dialogue recently.

A new season of hope seems to open now after a few years of work for putting water in a steady state.

The possibility of a new and direct relationship is shared by Polesella's citizens and by the coastal Municipalities.

Recently there are a lot of new cultural initiatives and recreational activities that repurpose a new way "to use" this big environmental treasure/wealth.

Polesella is also a country with a rustic charm characterized by the presence of our beautiful Ville Venete, their architecture, their inside art, their parks round, their defensive handmades and their Oratories.

ENVIRONMENT

The principal themes of the administration of the rural system concern the requalification and the transformation of the existing, the protection of the natural resources (soil, water and air) and the control of the energetic consumptions.

In particular:

- 1- We should protect, re-establish and increase the vegetation with hedges and with lost trees;
- 2- We should defend and increase the value of the area near the River Po with solutions through an economic support;
- 3- We should give value, also for a tourist aim, to the jetties that there are in our area to connect them with places full of services;
- 4- We should identify "ecological passages" and specific areas with a faunal interest like Fossa Polesella;
- 5- We should find, protect and give value to historical, architectural, artistic and environmental elements preparing an order of precedence in case of emergency;
- 6- We should support a "slow tourism" through the construction of new cycle tracks and pedestrian precincts for the public security.
