TAX ON ENVIRONMENTAL HYGIENE

In 2002 Polesella was the first municipal district in Rovigo's area to put on a tax for the environmental hygiene.

We did it in a reasonable way through the distribution of the harvesting, carriage and introduction to dumping cost for the urban rubbish.

The number of people in a family and the house's meters are important aspects to establish the cost to pay.

This innovation was not enough.

We all have a "common responsibility" for our rubbish and this is the key word in Decreto Ronchi (D.Lgs. 22/1997) and we hope it will become a slogan to awaken public opinion to the production, collection and the removal of the rubbish.

"Common responsibility" for the rubbish means that citizens, municipal districts and firms must find together real solutions to reduce the quantity of rubbish and to dispose of the waste in a correct way.

The possible solutions can be:

1- The differentiated collection of the rubbish;

At the moment it is at 63%.

We should improve this result given information to citizens;

2- Eco-Centre;

It will find economic difficulties and it will be offered collaboration to the municipal districts;

3- Oil Collection;

It will be active as soon as possible because it is a polluting substance and we cannot abandon it in our environment;

4- Special Rubbish collection (cartridges, toner);

This kind of rubbish could be expanded to private citizens as it is growing;

5- Collection of electric and electronic materials;

The use of these materials is growing also in the family and it is an alarming symptom if there is a wrong removal.
