PERIOD	April 2009 – October 2009
DESCRIPTION	The present proposal, being implemented in the framework of the twinning agreement between Polesella (Italy) and its twinned towns (Lucenec in Slovak Republic and Sanvincenti in Croatia) foresees the involvement of 3 partners representing 3 different "steps" – past, present and future – in the construction of the enlarged European Union.
ACTIONS	<p>The 3 main participating towns, together and in strict cooperation with their local communities (involving the most relevant stakeholders at the local level: local associations, schools, cultural associations, experts, citizens' groups...) and their neighbouring towns, will all play an active role in the preparation, implementation and evaluation of the two workshops. Around 100 people of the three communities are expected to be directly involved in the preparation phase.</p> <p>N. 2 workshops will take place: the first in Polesella – Italy (17th- 18th April 2009) and the second in Svetvinčenat - Croatia (9th – 10th October 2009)</p>
OBJECTS	<p>The aims is promoting action, reflection and debate on how education and arts may improve people's well being in their communities – and thus in Europe - and in their daily lives, through the development of a systematic exchange among the 3 towns involved which should serve as a basis for structuring and strengthening a long-lasting network of cooperation within the issues addressed and other issues of common interest. More specifically, the two workshops will focus on the following aspects</p> <p>1) Environment and education: The first workshop will analyze the links between education (especially focusing on the informal education) and environment, providing an unbiased platform encouraging debate and exchange of experiences between the participating towns. The main aim is to raise awareness about the importance of the education on environmental issues, which should be considered as a milestone to promote a sustainable development in Europe and in the whole world. The target group is represented by the whole communities involved, since this is a common challenge for all: however, a specific focus is given to students, young people, schools, universities, youth organisations, local associations directly affected by the topics addressed.</p> <p>2) Environment and arts: The second workshop will encourage debate and exchange of experiences on how "our" environment can be protected, promoted and valorised through arts. It aims at promoting the different landscapes which characterize the participating towns as natural "stages" where different forms of arts – music, dance, theatre, design, sculpture, etc. - may interact with the nature and respectfully exploit it, strengthening thus a sustainable "contamination" between the nature and the human beings activities. The priority target groups are represented by cultural associations, museums, cultural Institutions, educational services, youth organizations dealing with arts, etc.</p>
RESULTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A final publication will be realized as a "hand-book" (in order to be useful for other institutions which are interested to develop similar activities) with the contribution of all the partners and beneficiaries and with the direct involvement of all the relevant stakeholders. The publication represents an important outcome of the project and it will mainly aim at promoting a structured and sustainable thematic networking. It will be disseminated through the network of partners of all the participating towns. It will be also uploaded in the applicant's and partners' websites in order to grant its dissemination on an extensive basis in the enlarged Europe - 2 years action plan for implementing the thematic networking cooperation.
